Frequently Asked Subscription Questions

Q. Why should I become a Baldwin E.M.S. subscriber?

A. Most importantly, your subscription assures that Baldwin EMS will have the staff, vehicles and equipment required to provide around-the-clock protection for you and your family in the event of an emergency.

Secondly, subscribers will not be held responsible for any balances which are not paid by your insurance. Statistics show that a single ambulance transport co-pay or unpaid insurance balance typically far exceeds the cost of a subscription.

Q. If I have health insurance, do I need a subscription?

A. Yes. Your subscription assures that you will not receive any bills for medically necessary emergency medical care, regardless of your insurance coverage. Most insurance companies do not pay 100% of ambulance charges. **Your subscription covers any co-payments or deductibles.** Keep in mind that non-subscribers are responsible for full payment of all applicable charges; which often exceed \$600.00 per emergency medical response.

Q. Who is covered under my household subscription?

A. Your subscription covers all family members living at the listed address and non-resident guests or visitors who require emergency medical care, regardless of whether they are treated and/or transported to a hospital.

Q. Will Baldwin E.M.S. transport me to the local emergency department of my choice?

A. Yes. We will transport to any of the following local emergency departments: Allegheny General, Children's, Forbes, Jefferson, Mon Valley, Saint Clair, UPMC (East, Magee-Womens, McKeesport, Mercy, Presbyterian, Shadyside), VA Medical Center, West Penn Hospital and Western Psychiatric Institute and Clinic (WPIC).

Q. What should I do if my insurance company sends me a check for payment of ambulance services provided by Baldwin EMS?

A. The check must be remitted to Baldwin EMS. For a subscriber, this is considered payment in full for that particular service provided. If the check is not remitted to Baldwin EMS, the subscriber will be responsible for paying the entire bill. The insurance companies notify Baldwin EMS when the check has been mailed to the insured.

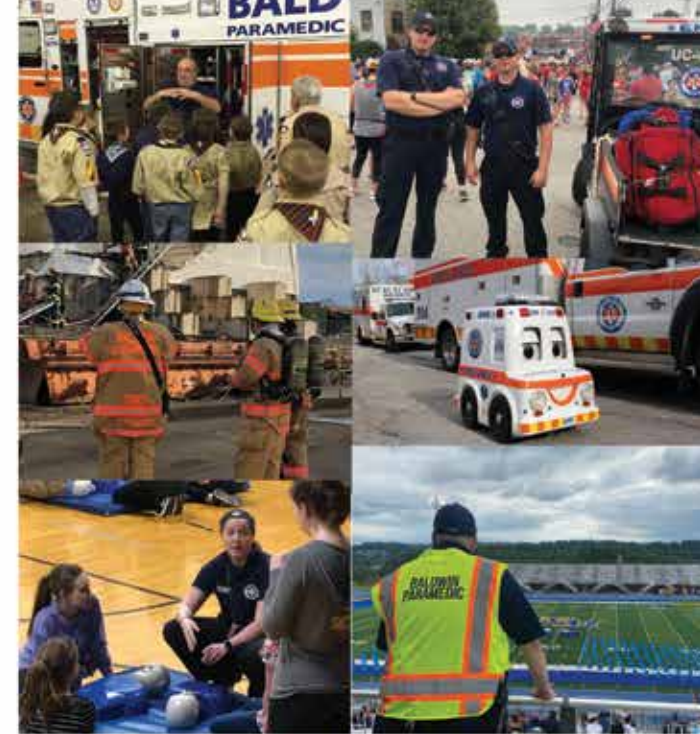
Mission Statement
